There is something magical about the bracing sea air and the piquancy of being in a new place each day. My desire to share this creative energy with others was the impetus to develop this range of Creativity and Writing workshops and courses, designed to be part of the Enrichment Program on vessels like yours.

My goal for these courses is to harness the inspiration we experience while traveling into a creative project that ignites passion and promise. I provide the structure, support, and motivation to translate inspiration into an idea, and then create a roadmap for executing a completed passion project.

Each of these courses is an invitation to participants to explore the world of creativity and writing in an informative, interactive, and supportive group environment. Crafted to accommodate different voyage lengths, each course empowers participants to begin a creative practice that will last long after the voyage has ended.

I hold "office hours" each sea day, inviting participants to discuss their ideas and projects on a one-to-one basis. Multimodule courses culminate in a final "salon" where ideas and works in progress can be shared with the larger community of cruise quests.

WRITING AROUND-THE-WORLD


FORTY-FIVE MODULES AFFORD AMPLE TIME TO LEARN ABOUT AND PRACTICE THE CRAFT OF WRITING



Writing Around the World is designed for the duration of an around-the-world voyage, with 45 modules, which introduce participants to a broad range of writing techniques such as narrative voice, point of view, plot, dialog, and setting. The length of the course affords ample opportunity for silent, sustained writing and presenting work for critique with fellow class participants. The course encourages participants to make significant progress on a creative writing project, or to explore multiple genres and techniques.

Writing at Sea 21 and Writing at Sea 10 are designed for longer voyages of 21+ days or selected consecutive segments of an around-the-world voyage. Each course presents aspects of writing techniques, such as plot, narrative voice, editing, as well as an overview of traditional genres and emerging forms such as blogs and newsletters.

The course aims to offer an inclusive introduction to creative writing and establish a writing practice that participants can continue when the journey has ended.

Jumpstart Your Creativity is a compact course of five 45-minute modules that create a roadmap of how to turn inspiration into a creative project of any kind. The course encourages participants to explore self-reflective writing as a tool for pursuing creativity, and tips on how to maintain the discipline and commitment necessary to get the project completed.

The format of the course includes sustained independent thought, PowerPoint presentations, and group discussion.

This standalone 45-minute interactive class provides a comprehensive overview of how to think about writing a book, considering genre, story arc, aspects of the writing life, and publishing options.


